



## Program Overview

The Mountain Range High School of Business™ program is an accelerated college program that develops students to be leaders and competitors in our 21st Century Workplace and in our global society. The program prepares students to learn the necessary skills to be successful in business and economics while also working towards fluency in a World Language. Students in the program are dual enrolled in high school and college with the opportunity to earn 21 transcribed credits in business, economics, finance, management, and marketing.

Students accepted into the High School of Business™ receive priority enrollment in English, math, science, and social studies Advanced Placement courses.



## MONEY SAVINGS

Students in the High School of Business™ take a sequence of concurrent courses. This means students will receive both **high school** and **college** transcripts.

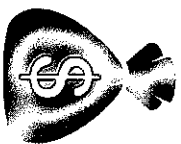
Students who successfully complete the High School of Business™ program will leave with 21 transcribed college credits. This has the potential to save students over **\$23,000** in college costs.
