<p>o Identify/ make inferences about explicit or implicit themes</p> <p>o Describe how word choice, point of view, may affect the reader's interpretation of a text</p> <p><b>o Explain, generalize, or connect ideas using supporting evidence (quote, example, text reference) (refer explicitly to the text as the basis for the answers - 3rd grade standard)</b></p>	<p>o Specify, explain, show relationships; explain why, identify cause-effect</p> <p>o Give non-examples /examples</p> <p>o Summarize results, concepts, ideas</p> <p>o Make basic inferences or logical predictions from data or texts</p> <p>o Identify main ideas or accurate generalizations of texts</p> <p><b>o Locate information to support explicit / implicit central ideas</b></p> <p><b>Answers to questions are generally in RAPP format</b></p>	<p>o Identify or describe literary elements (characters, setting, sequence, problem, solution)</p> <p>o Select appropriate words when intended meaning/definition is clearly evident</p> <p>o Describe/explain who, what, where, when, or how</p> <p>o Define/describe facts, details, terms, principles</p> <p><b>o Writes simple sentences to answer questions.</b></p>	<p>Identifies some literary elements, but is not secure in all of them.</p> <p>Is inconsistent in finding meaning of clearly evident words</p> <p>o Describe/explain some of who, what, where, when, or how</p> <p>Facts described may be irrelevant or not in the text</p> <p><b>Sentences are incomplete.</b></p>
